To Our Valued Customers:

Please note that as part of their Climate Change Plan, the Federal Government of Canada is increasing the price of carbon effective April 1st, 2022. The price per tonne is going up 25%, from \$40 to \$50. This follows the 33% increase that was implemented April 1st 2021, when the price rose from \$30 to \$40.

This increase effects multiple aspects of the economy and impacts costs across our entire supply chain ranging from fuel for transportation, to energy costs for heating, to equipment purchases and maintenance.

As a result of this change, we have incurred an increase in our overall costs. As such, it is necessary for us to increase our current Carbon Surcharge to **1.56%** effective April 1st, 2022 for all shipments handled across our network.
